COMMENT

A beautiful day and a beautiful week in perspective. As forecasted this week on the weather channels, today, like this week, there will be almost everything...; clouds, sun, snow and all, under mild temperatures. The centimeters of snow received yesterday and tonight gave us a perfect carpet on the surface. The trails groomed tonight are covered with a light powder and those made this morning, a groomed-on powder. Wow. Have a good day. Conditions: The maintenance teams did a good job last night and again this morning, more than twenty trails were groomed and worked, to allow you to enjoy the mountain in the best possible conditions. Thank you, gang, we appreciate your work. On groomed trails and glades, the snow will be granular, fine granular and sometimes the firm base could appear, especially at the end of the day and in steeper areas. On ungroomed trails or glades, on natural snow trails, your turns will be on firmed skied snow and bumpy surfaces. The lifts open today I, II, IIo, IV, VII and the magic carpet currently serving. A fun trail is now open on the Cascade trail, and the snow park is also open under Lift III. Chalets 400 and 840 are open with catering services and 680 as refuge only with fireplace. Trails that have been groomed, are displayed on the daily report to the main chalet or near the lifts. The alpine touring trails are all open!
