Conditions: Many of the runs were groomed by the crews last night and again this morning So, we're going to find both on man-made snow and natural snow runs; powder or powder mixed with granular snow in places on a firm to hard base For the runs that were left unworked and in the glades, it's going to be skied powder, deep snow still on the edges, all on a firm base that settles in the glades. So you can venture out without any problem and enjoy yourself. Changes are always possible after the patrol tour.
