### MOUNTAIN CODE OF CONDUCT

Code adopted under the Act respecting safety in sports. This Code applies to all persons practicing snow sports.

1. Remain in control of your speed and direction. Make sure you can stop and avoid any person or obstacle.
2. Yield the right of way to persons downhill and choose a course that ensures their safety.
3. Stop on a trail only if you are visible from above and if you are not obstructing the trail.
4. Yield the right of way to persons uphill when entering a trail and at intersections.
5. If you are involved in or witness an accident, remain at the scene and identify yourself to a first-aiders.
6. Use and wear at all times a proper device to prevent runaway equipment.
7. Keep out of the lifts and trails if your ability is impaired through use of alcohol or drugs.
8. Obey all signs and warnings and never venture off the trails or onto a closed trail.

The practice of snow gliding sports bears elements of risk that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce. Observe the Mountain code of conduct and share with others the responsibility for a great outdoor experience. You must show courtesy to others and obey all other rules and signs pertaining to any particular activity as marked out by the resort. Know the code. Be safety conscious. It is your responsibility!

The Ticket holder recognizes, accepts and assumes the inherent risks of snow sliding sports such as skiing and snowboarding. The Ticket holder assumes all risks of personal injury or any material damage resulting from the said risks. Among others, the following lists the elements considered inherent risks to the normal practice of a snow sliding sport:

- Changing climatic conditions;
- Changes in the steepness of the slope;
- The presence of natural obstacles and any other natural features, such as ditches, crevices and brooks, rocks, earth, uncovered spots, trees, tree regrowth, natural bushes and stumps, and any other natural obstacle;
- Ice and ice patches;
- Any change to surface condition;
- Collisions with skiers or other persons;
- The presence of pylons, poles and any other structures used in the operation of the ski area and collisions with these elements;
- The use of ski lifts;
- The presence on the slopes of grooming equipment and emergency vehicles and snowmaking equipment.

The contract in virtue of which the present ticket was issued is subject to the laws in force in Quebec. The holder of the present ticket, as well as the issuer of said ticket, agree to elect domicile in the judicial district of Bedford, province of Quebec and declare that same is the appropriate forum for any and all claims, of whatever nature, arising from the contract in virtue of which the present ticket was issued.

## SEASON PASS CONTRACT

**NO SEASON PASS WILL BE ISSUED BEFORE FULL PAYMENT.**

### GENERAL CONDITIONS

- In consideration of the payment of the subscription fee and of the subscriber's undertaking to abide by the Mountain Code of Conduct, the operator grants to the subscriber the right to use the facilities of the area and grants access to all non-prohibited areas of the grounds.
- In case of violation on the part of the subscriber, the privileges granted shall be revoked and the season pass automatically confiscated without further notice and without reimbursement to the subscriber.
- All season passes issued under the present subscription remain the property of the operator and the subscriber undertakes to return the season pass to the operator at the latter's request.
- The subscriber acknowledges that there are inherent risks and dangers attached to snow sports and the use of mechanical lifts; the subscriber assumes full responsibility for all damages, including bodily injuries, resulting from such inherent risks and dangers and hereby holds the operator free and harmless from any liability relating there to.
- The subscriber further assumes full responsibility for any damages of any nature resulting from a violation of the regulations and safety measures in force at the area and holds the operator free and harmless from any liability which could result there from.
- Season passes are non-transferable and non-refundable.

### USE OF THE SEASON PASS

- The season pass must be worn visibly at all times.
- It must be presented on every ride.
- Any fraud will result in the immediate cancellation of season pass.
- No credit or refund will be given due to shortage of snow.

### FORGOTTEN OR LOST SEASON PASS

- Any Member, without exception, who forgets their season pass will have to pay \$5 (taxes included) to purchase a day ticket.
- In case of loss or theft of the season pass, the subscriber must immediately notify administration. Another season pass will be issued against payment of a \$30 (taxes included) non-refundable amount.

### FAMILY SUBSCRIPTION

- In the case of a family subscription, the signatory of the subscription undertakes to inform all members of the family of the terms and conditions of the present subscription as well as of the duties and obligations of the holder of a season pass.
- The signatory undertakes to abide by, and to see to it that all members of his family holding a season pass shall abide by, the Mountain Code of Conduct.
- The signatory hereby acknowledges the operator's right to revoke and confiscate any and all season passes issued under the present subscription in case of violation of any condition contained herein.
- All season passes issued are subject to the terms and conditions of the present subscription and may be cancelled without refund on simple request by the operator.

### FAMILY PASS

- All direct family\* members must reside at the same address (principal residence only). A proof of residency (official identifications) will be required at the photo session for all members.
- Children must be 25 years old or less, please take note that children aged from 18 to 25 years must be full time students to be eligible for the Family Pass (an official student identification card validating full-time student status is required to have picture taken).
- \*Direct Family: spouses with their dependant legitimate and/or adopted children.

### CANCELLATION POLICY

**THE SEASON PASS IS NON REFUNDABLE EXCEPT WITH ADHERENCE TO THE "CANCELLATION PROTECTION PROGRAM".**

### LOCKERS

- This form must be completed, signed and returned along with your season pass contract and payment by November 1<sup>st</sup> 2019, after which non renewed lockers will no longer be reserved and will be rented to other skiers.
- Rental ends ten (10) days after the closing of the season and all lockers must be emptied by then. Please note that even if the lockers are reserved by the end of the previous ski season (springtime), all lockers must be emptied during the summer period.
- Locker rentals are not refundable.
- If not renewed by November 1<sup>st</sup> 2018, occupied lockers will automatically be billed to the user.
- Ski Sutton inc. is not responsible for contents of lockers. Damages to equipment kept in these lockers can only be covered by personal insurance against fire and theft.
- A fee of \$8 (taxes included) will be charged for a lost padlock.
