Inter-regional travel	<p>Not recommended. Visitors must apply the instructions associated to their local region when visiting. Skiers must plan in advance their travel time to be home before the 9:30pm curfew.</p>	<p>Not recommended. Visitors are limited to the practice of their sport while on site. Skiers must plan in advance their travel time to be home before the 8:00pm curfew.</p>
Base lodge and F&B	<p>Base lodge capacity adapted to the building size. Food services open/Bars closed, maximum of 2 adults per table with their children (under 18). Face-coverings are required for every visitors 10 years old and +. ¹ Frequent cleaning and disinfection for all high-touch areas.</p>	<p>Base lodge used as a shelter for guests to warm up, with limited access time. Sanitary facilities remain accessible.</p>
Services (Ski shop, Rentals, Lockers)	<p>Access will be limited in order to respect the 2m physical distancing. Face-coverings are required for every visitors 10 years old and +. ¹ Equipments are disinfected after each use.</p>	<p>Ski shop, rental and repair shop open. Lockers closed.</p>
Lifts	<p>Visitors from the same household are encourage to ride the lift together. Respect the 2m physical distance in lift lines. Face-coverings are required (3 years old and +).²</p>	<p>Precisions according to the type of ski lifts: For singles: Double, triple chairlifts and t-bars : Single occupancy Quad chairs : Occupancy = 2 (1 person seated at each end of the chair) Six seater chairs : Occupancy = 3 (1 person seated at each end + 1 person in the middle) Gondolas : Occupancy = 2 (1 person seated at each end) 1 household per lift = regular capacity Surface lifts: Respect 2 meters physical distance</p>
Snow School	<p>Face-coverings, like neck warmers, are required for all skiers of 3 years old and +.</p>	
	<p>Private and group lesson with a maximum of 8 people, excluding the instructor, provided that the distance of 2 meters is respected.</p>	<p>Private and group lesson with a maximum of 4 people, excluding the instructor, provided that the distance of 2 meters is respected.</p>
Federations and Competition Team	<p>Training with a maximum of 8 people per group, in addition to a supervisor. No competition.</p>	<p>Training with a maximum of 4 people per group, in addition to a supervisor. No competition.</p>

¹ Bring a spare face-covering to access the lodge.

² It can be a neck warmer, balaclava, neck gaiter or other accessories well adjusted that covers mouth and nose. This accessory should be made of 2 layers of fabric tight stitches and large enough to cover both the mouth and nose.
